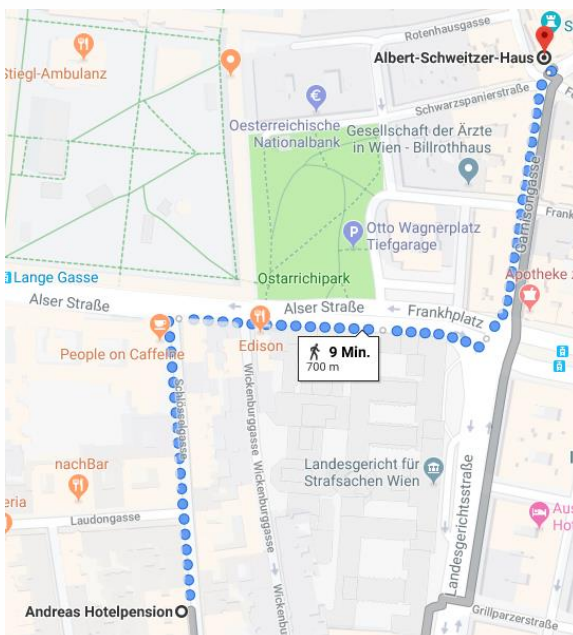

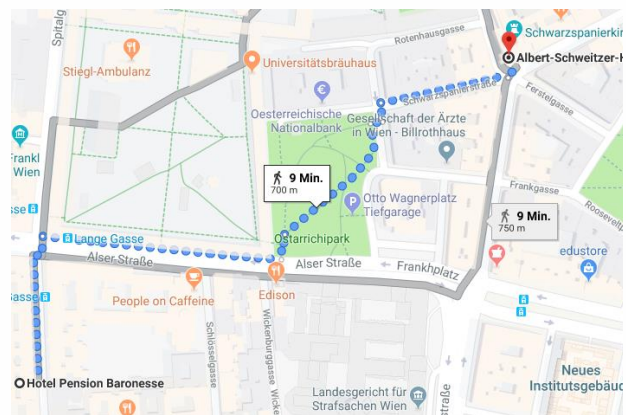

### Travel from airport (VIE) to Vienna (Terminal Wien-Mitte)



The **City Airport Train (CAT)** operates between Vienna International Airport and station Wien-Mitte (Landstraße) at a cost of €11 (one way) or €17 (return). The journey time is approximately 16 minutes. Trains run to the airport every 30 minutes from 5.36 a.m. to 11.06 p.m. and from the airport every 30 minutes from 6.09 a.m. to 11.39 p.m.

The **S7 line** operates between Vienna International Airport and station Wien-Mitte (Landstraße) at a cost of €3,90 (one way). The journey time is approximately 25 minutes. Trains run to the airport every 30 minutes from 4.19 a.m. to 11.49 p.m. and from the airport every 30 minutes from 4.48 a.m. to 0.18 a.m.

#### Time zone

CET (Central European Time) UTC/GMT + 1

#### Voltage/electricity

230 V (50Hz) and the power plugs and sockets are type F (also known as “Schuko”). This socket also works with plug C and plug E.
